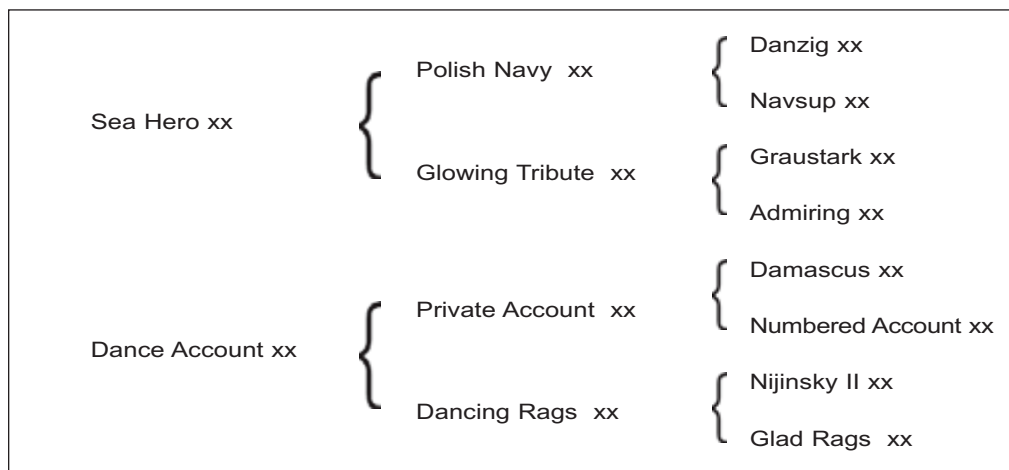

**Origin:** Sea Accounts is the son of Sea Hero, the winner of the 1993 Kentucky Derby and out of a stakes-winning Private Account's mare. His five generation pedigree contains 16 Chefs de Race and 17 Reines de Course. His lines have produced International jumper, dressage and eventers including current GP dressage TB, Sea Lord and CCI\*\*\* eventer, Sea Lion.

**Performance Record:** Sea Accounts has proven himself a Thoroughbred sport stallion in a class by himself by successfully completing the 2004 100-day stallion test with the 2nd highest score ever made by a TB stallion in North America, showed through 4th level dressage with scores in the 60s and in 2012, he returned to his eventing roots with a 3rd in OP at Holly Hill and ending the season with a win in OP at Texas Rose. Plans for 2013 have him competing at Intermediate.

**Breeding/Progeny Record:** He is producing winners in the Hunters, Jumpers and Eventing though his oldest offspring competing were born in 2005. One mare qualified for a CCI\* in four events. Another has won many Championships and Reserves in both Hunters to 3'5 and in the Jumpers to 3'9 at AA shows on the East Coast. A full Thoroughbred son has won multiple Championships to 3'. Additionally, a number began their eventing careers in 2012 with all earning top 3 finishes at Beginner Novice and Novice while ridden by Amateurs and Juniors.
